

Paddock & Parking Instructions

Sebring International Raceway (SIR)

For this Event we will be using the SIR Southern Paddock. This is the Paddock and Hot Pit area used for the annual 12 Hours of Sebring Pro-Event. In order to accommodate all entries, we must have the cooperation of all participants in the parking of their Race Rigs. Therefore, the following regulations will be **strictly enforced**.

1. As an overall comment, we emphasize that absolutely no Race Rigs will be allowed to Park parallel to any of the East/West roadways. This applies to the “main” North/South roadways as well. All parking must conform to the directions, and will be under the control, of the CFR Paddock Marshals.
2. Registration will be conducted during the hours published at the CFR Operations building located on the roadway outside the Track perimeter.
3. Timing & Scoring will be from the Tower located at the Start/Finish Line.
4. The Grid will be accessed at the gate approaching Turn 17. This area is roughly opposite the Tech/Impound Area.
5. No Rig parking will be allowed in the Impound, Scale, or Tech Areas. These are Area B’s as noted on the map.
6. There will be no Race Rig or Crew Parking in the “Reserved Vendor Area”. This area is identified as C on the Map.
7. Absolutely no parking will be allowed in the fenced area behind the Tower except for CFR/SCCA Officials such as Tower, and Pit personnel. On the Map, this is identified as Area A.
8. Other than the Restricted Areas, Camping will be allowed throughout the Paddock. Note that power and water connections are only available in the area immediately south and to the rear of the Pit Complex. Be aware that there may be a charge for using these utilities. No power or water connections are provided in the area identified as the “East Paddock”. Only self-contained camping vehicles should park in this area.
9. The SIR Public Address System will be utilized for announcements. This System provides a low voltage FM Radio signal as well as loud speakers. It is strongly suggested that all entrants bring an FM Radio and tune to 100.9 on the FM Dial in order to assure that they are aware of all PA announcements. This is especially true for those parking in the East Paddock area.
10. No Access will be allowed over the Bridge to the Green Park area. Further, No Access will be allowed beyond the start of the Photo Access Road in the East Paddock.
